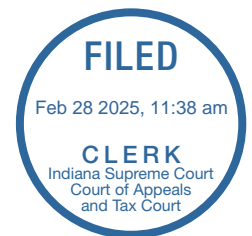

## Order

The Court has determined the above-captioned cases merit a consolidated oral argument. The appeals are not consolidated for any other purpose. 
**Thursday, April 10, 2025 at 10:00 a.m.**

The argument will be **forty** minutes in length, equally divided between the appellants and the appellees. If there are multiple appellants or appellees, the parties shall divide their side's allotted time among themselves as they deem appropriate. Any entity granted amicus curiae status may argue without further motion, but only with the consent of the parties with whom the amicus curiae is substantively aligned. Because the petitions to transfer jurisdiction are pending, the petitioners on transfer shall argue first.

Attorneys of record shall file an acknowledgement of the oral argument setting no later than fifteen days after service of this order and should arrive no later than 9:30 a.m. to complete an appearance form.
