What is PDHCS?

PDHCS allows an individual to hire a caretaker either licensed or unlicensed to provide skilled or attendant care activities.

The individual requires a chronic medical condition diagnosis, and services must be ordered by a physician or nurse practitioner.

What is needed to provide PDHCS?

The caregiver must have a personal services license or complete the following:

- Competency evaluation program or training and competency evaluation program approved by the American Association of Respiratory Care (AARC)
- CPR
- Basic first Aid
- Durable Medical Equipment Training (if needed)
