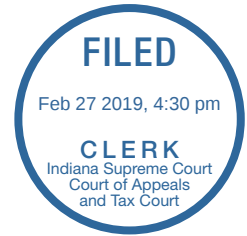

Order Establishing Senior Judge Per Diem

Effective March 21, 2018, Indiana Code § 33-23-3-5, provided that a senior judge shall be entitled to a per diem of \$175 per day for each of the first thirty (30) days of senior judge service in a calendar year. After the first 30 days of service a senior judge is entitled to a per diem of \$250 per day up to one hundred days of service. However, this Court may issue an order adjusting the compensation rate for service beyond thirty (30) days if the Court finds there would be insufficient funds to pay the \$250 per diem.

The Court now finds that in 2019 the Court's payroll fund will be sufficient to compensate senior judges at the rate of \$250 per day as provided by statute.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that, pursuant to Indiana Code § 33-23-3-5(a)(2), during calendar year 2019 the compensation rate for senior judge service, beginning with the thirty-first (31st) day of service through the one-hundredth (100th) day of service will be \$250 for each day. This Order shall remain in effect until further order of the Court.
