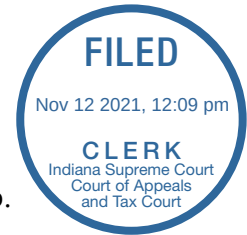

Order Revoking Judge Pro Tempore Appointment

The Honorable David C. Chapleau retired on July 15, 2021, creating a vacancy in St. Joseph Superior Court 6. In the interest of continuing the orderly administration of justice pursuant to Ind. Trial Rule 63, on August 17, 2021, Senior Judge Jeanene Calabrese was appointed as Judge Pro Tempore, beginning on August 31, 2021, to discharge the duties of judge of St. Joseph Superior Court 6, until the process for filling the vacancy was complete.

On October 5, 2021, the vacancy was filled when Governor Eric J. Holcomb announced Jamie C. Woods as his appointment to the St. Joseph Superior Court. The St. Joseph Superior Court has notified this court that Mr. Woods will be sworn in on November 12, 2021, and is prepared to discharge the duties of judge of St. Joseph Superior Court 6 beginning on November 12, 2021.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that Senior Judge Jeanene Calabrese's appointment as Judge Pro Tempore in St. Joseph Superior Court 6 will end, effective November 11, 2021, and Mr. Woods will begin the duties of judge of St. Joseph Superior Court 6 when he is sworn in on November 12, 2021.
