## Condition Name:

Hantavirus

## Condition Name in NBS:

- Hantavirus Infection
- Hantavirus pulmonary syndrome

## Reporting Timeframe:

Within One Working Day

## TO REPORT:

- NBS users: Report conditions via Morbidity Report in **NBS**
- Non-NBS users: Report with **this** form

## Associated Reportable Laboratory Results

- Detection of hantavirus-specific IgM or rising IgG titers by ELISA, hantavirus-specific RNA by PCR in clinical specimens, or immunohistochemistry in lung biopsy or autopsy specimens.

## Condition Specific Reporting Details

- Clinical, Epidemiologic, Lab Report, and Treatment Information sections within the NBS morbidity report.

## Additional Documentation to Include

- Applicable medical records (if available) including outpatient office visits, specialty consults, and emergency department/hospital discharge summaries.
- Travel history and known rodent or lab exposures
