Staff to Child Ratio Chart

Age of <u>Youngest</u> Child in Group	Maximum Number of Children Supervised by One (1) Caregiver	Maximum Number of Children in One (1) Group
Infants (6 Weeks to 12 Months)	1 to 5	Max 12
Young Toddlers (12- 17 Months)	1 to 5	Max 12
Older Toddlers (18 -23 Months)	1 to 6	Max 14
2 Years (24-29 Months)	1 to 8	Max 16
2.5-year-olds (30- 35 Months)	1 to 9	Max 17
3 Years (36 - 47 months)	1 to 11	Max 25
4 Years (48 - 59 months)	1 to 13	Max 29
5 Years (60 - 71 months)	1 to 17	Max 31
6 Years and over (72 months and older)	1 to 20	Max 40

- By definition a Toddler is from 12 months up to 29 months.
- Two-year-olds start at 24 months through to 35 months.
- 2.5 yr olds (30 months) may be combined with 3 yr olds only.

The maximum group size permitted is subject to the exceptions found in IC 12-17.2-4-14.5(l) and IC 12-17.2-4-14.5(m).
