1 MR. FEKETE: All right. I'd like to call  
2 to order the Chicago Waterway Management District  
3 Board of Directors' meeting. Today's date is  
4 December 19th, and the time is 5:10.

5 First order of business is the  
6 roll call. John Bakota?

7 MR. BAKOTA: Yes.

8 MR. FEKETE: Henry Rodriguez?

9 MR. HENRY RODRIGUEZ: Yes.

10 MR. FEKETE: Patrick Rodriguez?

11 MR. PATRICK RODRIGUEZ: Yes.

12 MR. FEKETE: Ted Zagar?

13 (No Response)

14 MR. FEKETE: Kevin Doyle?

15 (No Response)

16 MR. FEKETE: Ray Lopez?

17 MR. LOPEZ: Yes.

18 MR. FEKETE: John Fekete? Yes. We have a  
19 quorum.

20 Next order of business is the  
21 Executive Director's Report, Mr. Trevino.

22 MR. TREVINO: Fernando Trevino, FMT  
23 Consulting. I'd start off by going over the  
24 contents of your Board packet. You have the Board  
25 minutes for the meeting held November 21st, 2018.

1                   You have the CliftonLarsonAllen  
2 financial statement dated November 30, 2018. You  
3 have the claim docket for today's meeting, dated  
4 December 19th, 2018.

5                   You have First Merchants Bank  
6 statement for accounts ending in 608 and 616 for the  
7 month of November 2018. And you also have  
8 additional account information for the 12-month CD  
9 and 24-month CD that we have with First Merchants  
10 with accounts ending in 898 and 936.

11                   You have a modification to the  
12 lease agreement for the lease of our office space  
13 here and that's on agenda for approval.

14                   You have the CliftonLarsonAllen  
15 engagement letter for 2019.

16                   You have an FMT Consulting  
17 timesheet that I have requesting to be approved in  
18 your Board packet.

19                   You have a memorandum of  
20 understanding with the city of East Chicago and the  
21 Waterway Management District for the Canal Street  
22 Bridge Project.

23                   You have the 2018 FMT Consulting  
24 performance evaluation summary report.

25                   You have the ECI Facility Trust

1 report dated November 30, 2018.

2 And you have BMO account  
3 statement for account ending in 712 for the month of  
4 November 2018.

5 You have Army Corps of Engineers  
6 report to the Board dated December 19, 2019, and an  
7 Indiana Harbor dredging volume by year map dated  
8 December 2018.

9 You have Attorney Ellen  
10 Gregory's report to the Board, with revision date of  
11 December 17, 2018.

12 You have Atlantic Richfield  
13 report, monthly progress report number 45, for the  
14 former ECI refinery site investigations activity,  
15 and that's dated December 5, 2018.

16 And you have several progress  
17 reports from Parsons. The first month is June of  
18 2018 and you have every month through November of  
19 2018. So every once in awhile they fall behind and  
20 then send them all at one time. You have June  
21 through November of 2018.

22 You have an e-mail from EPA's  
23 Christina Miller, basically giving us summary  
24 information of the former Exxon Mobile building  
25 facility that's located in East Chicago, and three

1 attachments that were affiliated with the e-mail,  
2 which includes a brief history of the site, a 2001  
3 administrative order related to the site, and a  
4 progress report dated August 14, 2018 related to the  
5 site.

6 That concludes the Board  
7 contents in your Board packet. I'd like to go over  
8 a few things.

9 As I mentioned the 2018  
10 performance evaluation report is in your packet. I  
11 want to thank the Board for participating in the  
12 performance survey. I appreciate your comments and  
13 looking forward to 2019 and continuing the hard work  
14 that we are doing on the projects here in the  
15 Waterway.

16 Great Lakes Legacy Cost Share  
17 Agreement that the Board approved with Arco/BP has  
18 been fully executed. We have signed it and Arco/BP  
19 has signed it. Administrative order of consent also  
20 has been signed between the EPA and Arco, and we are  
21 waiting on the project agreement to be signed by EPA  
22 and is going through their approval process. Both  
23 Arco and BP and Waterway Management District have  
24 already signed off on the project agreement. We had  
25 a project kickoff meeting last week on the 13th.

1 Because of so many different projects and activities  
2 affiliated with that Great Lakes Legacy Act Project,  
3 we wanted to make sure we got a good fresh start, so  
4 we held a project kickoff meeting last week. So  
5 there is a lot of follow-up and action items  
6 affiliated with that. So we'll continue to work  
7 with EPA, Arco and BP, and some of the other  
8 stakeholders to make sure that the project goes as  
9 best as possible.

10 The dredge project. There's a  
11 status report in your packet, and I mentioned that  
12 there is also a dredging colored map that kind of  
13 shows you which areas have been dredged per year,  
14 and also it includes a volume calculation.

15 The 2019 budget approval is  
16 still going through the EPA approval process. The  
17 feedback I get is that they don't have any issues,  
18 it's just going through their approval process.

19 I attended a meeting last week  
20 with the Army Corps of Engineers management,  
21 including their Colonel and General, which was a  
22 pleasure. First General I got to meet, that was  
23 kind of cool. And so we were discussing the CDF and  
24 the dredging projects, kind of history and the  
25 current issues going on with the projects.

1 Summary of the action items.

2 You have the traditional accounts payable voucher  
3 dated December 19, 2018. You have a Lease Agreement  
4 Amendment, that's for the lease of the office space  
5 and the conference room that we are in now, and that  
6 in includes a \$50 increase in our monthly rent, and  
7 it's for 2019 calendar year.

8 You have CliftonLarsonAllen  
9 engagement letter for 2019. We do that every year  
10 to renew the engagement that we have with  
11 CliftonLarsonAllen.

12 You have FMT Consulting  
13 timesheet that's in your packet, and I'm asking to  
14 be approved because I thought it needed to be  
15 revised to reflect some of the current projects that  
16 we have in front of us, particularly the Canal  
17 Street Bridge, that was new, and the Great Lakes  
18 Legacy Act Project.

19 And you also have for approval  
20 the 2019 monthly executive public meetings that are  
21 listed on your agenda.

22 And Attorney Ellen Gregory will  
23 be giving an update on various legal matters. And  
24 that concludes my report.

25 MR. FEKETE: Any questions for Mr.

1 Trevino?

2 Comments/Questions: None.

3 MR. FEKETE: Next order of business is  
4 approval consideration of the Board meeting notes  
5 for last month's meeting, and that date was  
6 November 21st, 2018.

7 MR. LOPEZ: Motion to approve.

8 MR. BAKOTA: Second.

9 MR. FEKETE: All signify by saying aye.

10 (All signify aye.)

11 MR. FEKETE: Motion carries. Accounting  
12 Consultant report, Mr. Anderson.

13 MR. ANDERSON: Tim Anderson, CLA.  
14 Everybody has got a copy this month.

15 MR. TREVINO: It was included in their  
16 Board packet.

17 MR. ANDERSON: Okay. Page 2 of our report  
18 is the first page with numbers on it. Up at the top  
19 you have got your receipts, this does not include  
20 the Trust. This is our Operating Account and the  
21 User Fee Account, does not include the Trust money.  
22 Interest income 18,000 on those two checking  
23 accounts. User fees 357,000, and of course the  
24 transfer out of the Trust, the 224. Then you can  
25 see our disbursements. So we have written checks

1 for 324,000 through November. Started the year with  
2 3,007,000 and we have 3.3 at the end of November,  
3 and it's broken down below; 722,000 for the  
4 Operating Account, which is basically our unused  
5 budget and the User Fee, 611. And then we bought  
6 those two CDs.

7                   The next page, page 3, shows the  
8 actual activity of those accounts. Up at the top is  
9 the User Fee group -- not the User Fee, that's our  
10 general checking at the top. That's where we write  
11 our checks out of and we put the Trust transfer in  
12 there. That's got 722,000 in it. And then the User  
13 Fee account started the year with 2.2 million. We  
14 transferred two million out of there to buy those  
15 two CDs. And if you look down at the bottom, I  
16 don't know whose decision it was to buy CDs, but we  
17 made \$12,000 on those things. That's pretty good,  
18 almost pay for your accounting fees. That's nice.  
19 Smart move there guys.

20                   Page 4 is the important page.  
21 This has got the budget and where we are at. So  
22 today you have a voucher register that's got \$18,826  
23 on it, after you cut those checks, which this will  
24 be the last one for the calendar year. So we have  
25 not exceeded any line item on the budget, which is

1 what you look for. So everything is in line. We  
2 had a little issue, we prepaid the rent and so they  
3 were kind enough to let us wait until January to cut  
4 the check, so you guys didn't have to make a budget  
5 amendment, which is kind of nice of them. We'll pay  
6 two payments in January. One for January and then  
7 we get back on track, and you should budget a little  
8 extra in rent so we can pay that last one timely.

9 MR. TREVINO: We'll probably do a budget  
10 amendment because the other thing, we added the \$50.  
11 I think that happened after the budget was  
12 established.

13 MR. ANDERSON: Well, that was the only  
14 item we are even close on.

15 MR. TREVINO: Scratch that, we might have  
16 already put that in there, in the 2019.

17 MR. ANDERSON: Okay. So any questions on  
18 this part? And then we have to do the transfer --  
19 right -- the budget transfer.

20 MR. TREVINO: Yes.

21 MR. ANDERSON: Which I'm sure Fernando is  
22 all over. With the State Board of Accounts we have  
23 to file one form by the end of January, which I will  
24 prepare, and then Ray will submit. And then we do  
25 the annual report by March 1st, which we will.

1 MR. TREVINO: We are waiting on the 2019.  
2 We'll start doing the calculation for the cash  
3 balance and all that. I put it together first and  
4 you kind of double check it.

5 MR. ANDERSON: And we have a lot of cash  
6 in that account. So we might not have to transfer  
7 much out of the Trust, depending on what you are  
8 planning on doing with the budget.

9 MR. TREVINO: And again, I think we might  
10 have -- I don't remember when the \$50 increase came,  
11 whether it was -- and I don't have the 2019 budget  
12 summary in front of me -- may have already been  
13 incorporated.

14 MR. FEKETE: I'll double check.

15 MR. ANDERSON: If the \$50 is our biggest  
16 problem, we're in pretty good shape. Whatever the  
17 budget amount is, it's not over what we have in the  
18 Operating Account and we're building cash in that  
19 account.

20 MR. TREVINO: But we'll have enough cash  
21 to cash balance, but we typically wait for the EPA  
22 and IDEM approval before we start spending on it.

23 MR. ANDERSON: We can pull the money out  
24 of the Trust to pay our operating, and it seems like  
25 we are really building up because we are not

1 spending what we budgeted.

2 MR. TREVINO: Well, then there is a  
3 500,000 that's affiliated with the Great Lakes  
4 Legacy Act Project, that has been carried over a  
5 couple years now. That hasn't been touched. That's  
6 kind of the bulk of the cash balance.

7 MR. ANDERSON: I wonder what would happen  
8 if you have more cash in that account than what you  
9 have budgeted expense? That's all I've got.

10 MR. FEKETE: Thank you. Next order for  
11 approval consideration is the accounts payable  
12 voucher register that was presented. It's dated  
13 December 19, 2018.

14 MR. HENRY RODRIGUEZ: Motion to approve.

15 MR. BAKOTA: Second.

16 MR. FEKETE: Roll call vote. John Bakota?

17 MR. BAKOTA: Yes.

18 MR. FEKETE: Henry Rodriguez?

19 MR. HENRY RODRIGUEZ: Yes.

20 MR. FEKETE: Patrick Rodriguez?

23 MOU.

24 MR. TREVINO: Let me just if I may, Mr.

25 President, just add that the draft that was

1 submitted to you in your Board packet had a blank  
2 under paragraph 3, which the City hereby designates  
3 as its contact person. And I have had a  
4 conversation with the City and they are asking that  
5 that person be Val Gomez. I'll insert that in the  
6 blank, that will be what the Board is approving.

7 MR. FEKETE: Okay. So, approving the  
8 draft before you with Mr. Gomez's name added in the  
9 spot under the paragraph, third paragraph, I  
10 believe.

11 MR. TREVINO: Yes. It's on page 3,  
12 paragraph 3.

13 MR. LOPEZ: That's the amendment?

14 MR. TREVINO: No, we are just filling in  
15 the blank.

16 MR. FEKETE: Okay. Entertain a motion to  
17 approve.

18 MR. BAKOTA: Motion to approve.

19 MR. HENRY RODRIGUEZ: Second.

20 MR. FEKETE: Roll call vote. John Bakota?

21 MR. BAKOTA: Yes.

22 MR. FEKETE: Henry Rodriguez?

23 MR. HENRY RODRIGUEZ: Yes.

24 MR. FEKETE: Patrick Rodriguez?

9 that we are asking to be approved are the third  
10 Wednesday of the month, at 4:00 o'clock for the  
11 Executive meeting, and 5:00 o'clock for the Public  
12 Meeting, which is consistent with our schedule that  
13 we have had for the last several years.

14 MR. BAKOTA: Motion to approve.

15 MR. HENRY RODRIGUEZ: Second.

16 MR. FEKETE: Roll call vote. John Bakota?

17 MR. BAKOTA: Yes.

18 MR. FEKETE: Henry Rodriguez?

19 MR. HENRY RODRIGUEZ: Yes.

20 MR. FEKETE: Patrick Rodriguez?

21 MR. PATRICK RODRIGUEZ: Yes.

1                                   Next order of business is the  
2 FMT Consulting performance evaluation summary.

3                   MR. TREVINO: Gentlemen, again I just  
4 wanted to mention that, per my contract, at the end  
5 of the year the Board does an evaluation of my  
6 performance. And I appreciate the Board's input to  
7 the report and look forward to continuing the hard  
8 work into 2019. If there is any questions on the  
9 report, I'll answer them.

10                   MR. FEKETE: Any questions for Mr.  
11 Trevino?

12 Comments/Questions: None.

13                   MR. FEKETE: BMO Harris Trust report.

14                   MR. TREVINO: You have a copy of BMO Trust  
15 report. Just to go over a couple of the highlights  
16 in the report. Page 1 is the highlights of the  
17 historical value of the Trust since 1997, and also  
18 the distributions each year since 1997. The current  
19 value of the Trust is approximately 4.727 million,  
20 and that's as of November 30th. This is an increase  
21 of approximately \$62 from the last meeting, and it's  
22 due to the increase in the Money Market. No CD  
23 interest or credit until the end of January.

24                                   Page 3, shows the values of the  
25 Money Market. Essentially business checking account

1 and CD. The next interest for CD payout at the tend  
2 of January of next year. And those CDs are  
3 scheduled to mature until June or July of next year.

4 That's a quick summary of the  
5 BMO Harris report.

6 MR. FEKETE: Next order of business is the  
7 U.S. Army Corps report.

8 MR. TREVINO: You have the summary of the  
9 Army Corps report in your Board packet. Dredging  
10 was completed September 21st, of 2018. I have  
11 provided you a copy of their volume calculation.  
12 Mike had sent a previous e-mail that had an error in  
13 the quantity of dredging that occurred in 2018. The  
14 correct amount is -- per Mike Winn -- is 162,592  
15 cubic yards.

16 And regarding the Parkway  
17 Improvement, the contractor's preparing submittal  
18 for the quarter review. The entrance and road  
19 resurfacing, the contractor will be submitting a  
20 proposal for approval. That concludes a brief  
21 summary of the Corps report.

22 MR. FEKETE: I'd ask for, and I will try  
23 to get larger copies of that, like 11 by 16 printed  
24 out so that you can have it at your disposal. Next  
25 Board meeting I look to have handout of Army Corps

1 map. It's kind of shrunk down and sometimes it's  
2 hard to duplicate.

3 MR. TREVINO: The other thing -- I should  
4 have added this, I'm sorry -- the Corps is routing a  
5 final determination letter regarding the Feddeler  
6 parcel. So we are expecting a letter with that with  
7 their final determination soon.

8 MR. FEKETE: Next order of business is  
9 Attorney Ellen Gregory's report.

10 MS. GREGORY: Ellen Gregory, Ellen Gregory  
11 Law. Couple of items. Fernando mentioned briefly  
12 I've been working on the legal aspects, including  
13 the great Lakes Legacy Act, the legal issues are  
14 diminishing. I'll probably be spending less time on  
15 the Great Lakes Legacy Project as the technical work  
16 comes to the floor and the legal aspects kind of  
17 trail off. I did participate in the project,  
18 kickoff meeting by phone last week, and I'll be  
19 participating in future calls and meetings, only on  
20 as needed basis if legal issues come up.

21 The Canal Street Bridge MOU with  
22 the City, one of the items I've been working on last  
23 month and has been finalized, with respect to  
24 placement of booms in the Canal. Fernando and I  
25 were trying to set up a meeting to discuss Section

1 10 permit for the booms in the Canal, INDOT permit,  
2 which is for attaching the boom to the Indianapolis  
3 Boulevard bridge. The INDOT permit expires the end  
4 of January of 2019. That's all I have.

5 MR. FEKETE: Any questions for Miss  
6 Gregory?

7 Comments/Questions: None.

8 MR. FEKETE: Thank you very much. Any new  
9 business to come before the Board? New Business  
10 (none) Other Business (none).

11 MR. LOPEZ: Before we adjourn I'd like to  
12 wish everybody a Merry Christmas, and also our  
13 stenographer.

14 MR. PATRICK RODRIGUEZ: Mr. President, I'd  
15 just like to thank Peggy for a great job this year  
16 on our minutes. Thank you.

17 MR. FEKETE: Public comments. (None)

18 MR. PATRICK RODRIGUEZ: Motion to adjourn.

19 MR. HENRY RODRIGUEZ: Second.

20 MR. FEKETE: All signify by saying aye.

21 (All signify aye.)


