

Notice is hereby given that the Indiana Office of Community and Rural Affairs (OCRA), and the Indiana Housing and Community Development Authority (IHCDA) will file their 2019 CAPER with the U.S. Department of Housing & Urban Development on December 21, 2020.

These programs are funded through the U.S. Department of Housing & Urban Development under Title I of the Housing & Community Development Act of 1974 as amended. Annually, the state receives approximately \$50 million for housing and community development funds. This document governs the reporting of spending on activities.

The CAPER provides information on the expenditures on activities with regard to the Community Development Block Grant Program, the Home Investment Partnership (HOME) Program, the Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) Program, the Housing Opportunities for Persons with Aids Program, and the National Housing Trust Fund (NHTF). CARES Act funds will be reported as expended.
