What is VMOD?

VMOD allows for the addition of adaptive equipment or structural changes to a vehicle to ensure safe transfer of individuals.

The following are approved modifications:

- Wheelchair lifts
- Wheelchair tie downs
- Wheelchair/scooter hoist
- Wheelchair/scooter carrier for roof or back of vehicle
- Raided roof and raided door openings
- Power transfer seat base

VMOD has a lifetime cap of \$15,000 for 1 vehicle/every 10 years and a \$1,000 annual cap for repairs.

What is needed to provide VMOD?

Resume demonstrating experience with vehicle modifications.

How to apply for VMOD?
