RESPITE provides temporary/periodic relief for the usual caregiver of an individual.

RESPITE is provided as:

- Home Health Aide services (RHHA)
- Respite care nursing services (RNU)

What is needed to provide RESPITE?

Must have Home Health Agency License.

How to apply for RESPITE?
