Condition Name:

Hemolytic uremic syndrome (HUS), post-diarrheal

Condition Name in NBS:

Hemolytic uremic synd, postdiarrheal

Reporting Timeframe:

Immediately

TO REPORT:

Step 1: Call **317-233-7125**

317-233-1325 (After hours)



Step 2:

- NBS users: Report conditions via Morbidity Report in **NBS**
- Non-NBS users: Report with **this** form

Associated Reportable Laboratory Results

- Any laboratory results pertaining to diarrheal pathogen testing
- Testing related to HUS such as microangiopathic hemolytic anemia, renal injury, Thrombocytopenia (TTP), platelet count, creatinine level, etc.

Condition Specific Reporting Details

- Clinical, Epidemiologic, Lab Report, and Treatment information sections within the NBS Morbidity Report

Additional Documentation to Include

- Applicable lab results (including any *E. coli* lab results)
- Applicable patient medical records (if available)
- Clinical documentation of HUS or Thrombotic thrombocytopenic purpura (TTP)
- Any noted exposure history, including travel
