Condition Name:

Reporting Timeframe:

Within One Working Day

TO REPORT:

- NBS users: Report conditions via Morbidity Report in **NBS**
- Non-NBS users: Report with **this** form

Associated Reportable Laboratory Results

- Positive IFA IgG antibody titers, detection of SFR DNA by PCR, IHC, cell culture, ELISA, dot-ELISA, or latex agglutination

Condition Specific Reporting Details

- Clinical, Epidemiologic, Lab Report, and Treatment Information sections within the NBS morbidity report

Additional Documentation to Include

- Applicable medical records (if available) including outpatient office visits, specialty consults, and emergency department/hospital discharge summaries.
- Name and contact information of follow up provider should be listed in the Administrative Comments section of the morbidity report.
