**Comments:** Mr. Reeves at the Owen County Health Department was helpful. He said the source closed in the early summer of 2024. However, over the late summer, the source sold off the material already quarried from the previous winter which involved shoveling aggregate into tri-axle trucks. The crushers, screens, and conveying equipment have been sold, according to Mr. Reeves, along with the aggregate to pay off debt. The parent company location for JW Jones (located at 2468 SR 67 in Paragon a few miles north of Eagle Stone) is for sale and no one was on site. Both properties appear abandoned. Based on the above information, I believe the source no longer operates. Please revoke the SSOA.
