Order Amending Rules of Appellate Procedure

Under the authority vested in this Court to provide by rule for the procedures employed in all courts of this state and this Court's inherent authority to supervise the administration of all courts in this state, the Indiana Rules of Appellate Procedure are amended as follows (deletions shown by ~~strike through~~ and new text shown by underlining):

Rule 9. Initiation of the Appeal

...

F. Content of Notice of Appeal. The Notice of Appeal shall include the following:

...

(8) *Attachments.*

...

(d) A copy of the order from the Court of Appeals accepting jurisdiction over the interlocutory appeal, if proceeding pursuant to Rule 14(B)(3) or 14(C)(5);
