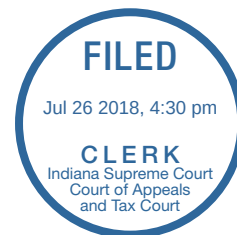

Order Amending Indiana Rules of Criminal Procedure

Under the authority vested in this Court to provide by rule for the procedure employed in all courts of this state and this Court's inherent authority to supervise the administration of all courts of this state, the Indiana Rules of Criminal Procedure are amended as follows (deletions shown by striking and new text shown by underlining):

...

Rule 2.1. Appearance

...

(D) Unrepresented. In the event a defendant decides to represent himself or herself in a criminal proceeding without assistance of counsel, the defendant shall file an appearance that includes the defendant's name, address, telephone number, and e-mail address on a form as provided in section (H).

...

This amendment shall take effect upon January 1, 2019.
