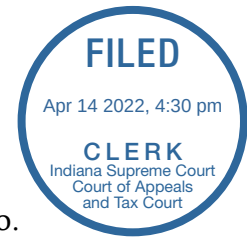

Order Appointing Judge Pro Tempore

The Honorable Karen M. Love, Judge of the Hendricks Superior Court Div. 3, previously notified this court that she will be periodically unavailable to fulfill her duties due to medical treatments. On January 4, 2022, Judge Mark Jones was appointed to serve as Judge Pro Tempore in the Hendricks Superior Court Div. 3, beginning on January 10, 2022. Judge Jones has notified this court that he is unavailable to serve as Judge Pro Tempore after April 27, 2022. Senior Judge Heather Mollo has expressed willingness to serve as Judge Pro Tempore in the Hendricks Superior Court Div. 3, beginning on April 28, 2022.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that pursuant to Ind. Trial Rule 63, Senior Judge Heather Mollo is appointed Judge Pro Tempore in the Hendricks Superior Court Div. 3, effective April 28, 2022.

This Order shall be sufficient authority for Judge Mollo to continue the employment of court personnel and otherwise discharge the duties of Judge of the Hendricks Superior Court Div. 3. Judge Mollo shall be entitled to compensation for her service, paid by the State of Indiana, computed at the same rate as the regular judge commencing from the effective date of his appointment, pursuant to Trial Rule 63(D).
