Notes:

- "Required/Trigger" indicates results that are reportable regardless of other test results when test type/result type combination is met.
- "Concurrent Results" refer to results collected around the same time as a triggering positive hepatitis B, C, or D result.
- [^]Potential future commercial test in process of being approved by FDA - positive reportable if run by facility or reference lab
- Conditional Required/Trigger specifications:
 - *Required as a triggering event only in patients less than or equal to 2 years of age at time of specimen collection
 - ⁺Required as a triggering reporting event only in patients less than or equal to 36 months/3 years of age at time of specimen collection.
 - [^]Pregnancy Status - if reporting via HCG value must be a concurrent test within ± 2 days of the ordered test date or specimen collection date of the triggering positive Hepatitis B/C/D test value.
