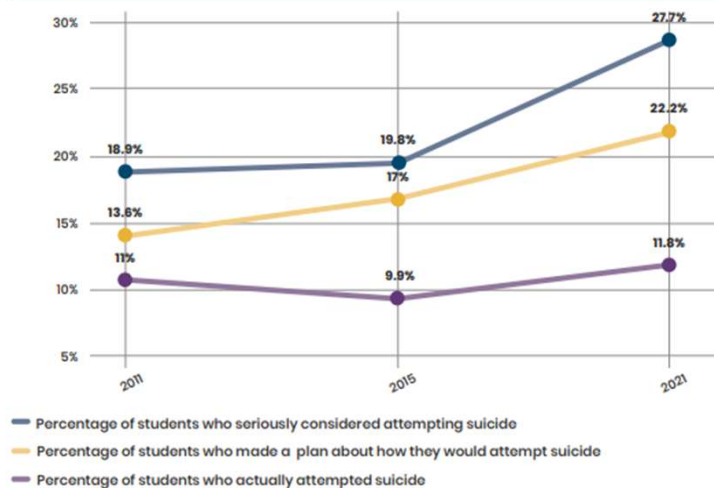
70% of youth are sexually abused by another minor



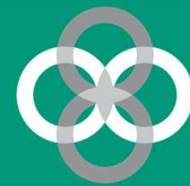

- Engaging in sexual conversation with a minor

- Purpose is exploit or abuse a minor
- Happening to kids as young as 9 years of age.

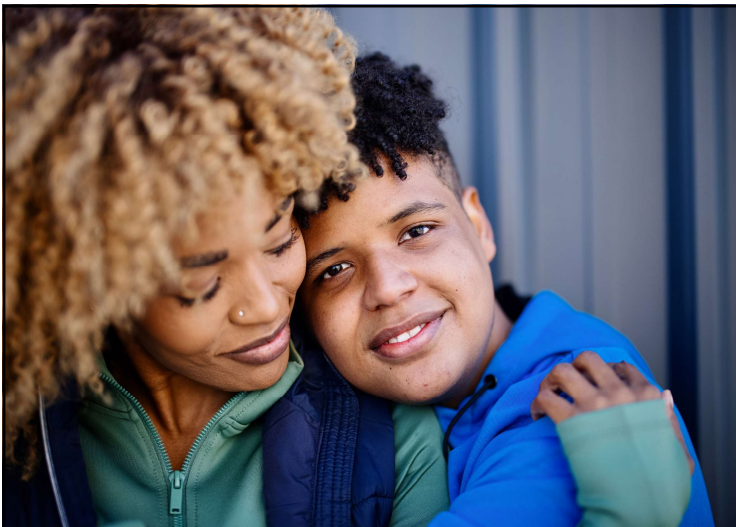

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Early, Open, Often

- Use proper names of body parts.
- Establish family rules regarding privacy, dating, and online safety.
- Talk about relationships and safety
 - Play the “What If” game
- Use teachable moments
 - Books
 - Movies or TV Shows
 - News Articles
- Create a safety plan
 - Digital
 - In-person
 - Safe Adults

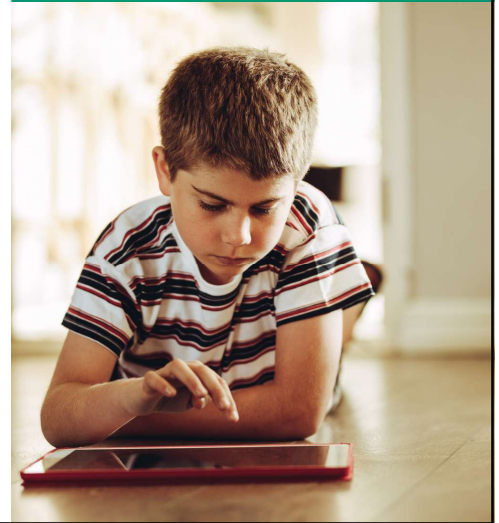

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Digital Safety Tips

- Set-up parental controls
- Device bedtime
- No-screen zones
- Be curious! Ask your child about their online activities.
- Spot check their online activities.

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- ✓ Talk openly about mental health and stressors.
