# BACKGROUND

The Child Support Bureau (CSB) has a Cooperative Agreement with each Clerk of Court to provide child support services. The Personal Responsibility and Work Opportunity Reconciliation Act of 1996 (PRWORA) added a Title IV-D State Plan requirement that the State agency will operate a State Disbursement Unit (SDU) on or after October 1, 1998.<sup>1</sup> This new requirement for each State to have a SDU has greatly reduced the role of the Clerk of Courts in collecting child support payments, from collecting virtually all payments to collecting only walk-in cash payments.<sup>2</sup>

The Title IV-D role of the Clerk of Courts include:

- 1. Maintaining child support payment records;
- 2. Updating party information;
- 3. Collecting, posting, and disbursing walk-in cash payments;
- 4. Processing orders established within its Courts;
- 5. Entering child support order information into the statewide child support system; and
- 6. Distributing payment records and histories to parties upon request.<sup>3</sup>
