



National Youth in Transition Database (NYTD) 17-Year-Old-Survey

Begins Oct. 1, 2022 and ends Sept. 30, 2023.

NYTD is a data collection system that tracks the independent living services States provided to older youth/young adults and assesses States' performance in operating their independent living programs. The NYTD survey is a component of this that assesses youth outcomes and assists lawmakers and child welfare agencies in identifying the needs of young people through youth voice

- All youth in foster care that turn 17 during this period, must take the survey within **45-days**.
- 17-year-olds must complete this survey within the allotted time or Indiana may receive a financial penalty. This could impact services available for youth and young adults transitioning out of foster care.
