



Ireland Home Based Services

Community Partners for Child Safety Monthly Summary April 2015

As of April 30, 2015, a total of 31 open cases are currently being serviced through Community Partners for Child Safety.



In the month of April, a total of 24 new referrals were made for consideration for service and 19 were serviced. Two referred families failed to engage in services. Two referred families were unable to be located. One referred family declined to engage in services.

Of the referrals, six cases came from Dearborn County, two from Decatur County, nine from Jefferson County, one from Ohio County, six from Ripley County, and zero from Switzerland County.

Sources of referrals (Partners) for this month included Dearborn County Department of Child Services (4), Decatur County Department of Child Services (2), Jefferson County Department of Child Services (5), Ripley County Department of Child Services (5), One Community One Family (1), Darlisa's Little Darlings (1), Safe Passage (1) and self-referrals (5).

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


