

Transition From Restrictive Placement

Location: Any (Home, Office, Community)

Client: Child

Duration: Long Term – One Year

Payer: DCS/MCO/MRO

Summary:

This service assists children in a more restrictive placement as they transition to a less/least restrictive placement. The purpose of the program is to prevent a return of the youth to a more restrictive setting/placement.

Services include Therapeutic/clinical interventions to address the service needs of the youth and family based on an evidence-based model such as Functional Family Therapy (FFT), Multi-systemic Therapy (MST), Parenting with Love and Limits (PLL), or similar program.

Home-based services including but not limited to the following:

- Home assessment
- Child development education
- Educational transition services
- Vocational services
- Drug/alcohol screening & monitoring
- Conflict management
- Addiction Education
- Group Therapy
- Coordination of services, with special emphasis on education and employment services
- Other services as deemed appropriate based on the needs of the youth and family
- Emergency/crisis services
- Parenting education/training
- Family communication
- Assistance with transportation
- Family reunification
- Family assessment
- Community referrals and follow-up
- Behavior modification
- Budgeting/money management
