PROCLAMATION

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY COME, GREETINGS:

- WHEREAS, Emergency Management professionals serve as Indiana's trusted coordinators during disasters and major incidents, providing critical guidance and collaboration across public safety disciplines and government agencies; and
- WHEREAS, Indiana's Emergency Management Agencies work around the clock to help communities prepare for, respond to, recover from and mitigate the impact of both natural and manmade disasters, ensuring continuity and resilience across the state; and
- WHEREAS, Emergency Managers are among the first to recognize potential hazards, connect resources and develop comprehensive response strategies, often serving as the behind-the-scenes backbone of public safety; and
