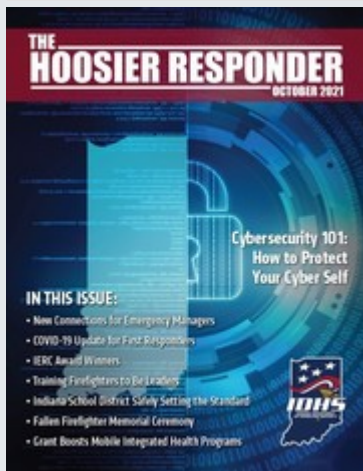

The FEMA National Exercise Division has closed fall submissions for the exercise support program from the National Exercise Program (NEP). Decisions will be sent out by **Dec. 10, 2021**.

The NEP offers no-cost assistance to state, local, tribal and territorial jurisdictions for exercise design, development, execution and evaluation to validate capabilities across all mission areas.

For jurisdictions who were not ready to submit a request by the deadline, the NEP will hold additional exercise support rounds in spring and fall of 2022. If you have any questions, please contact the [National Exercise Division](#).

The Request for Public Assistance deadline remains open. A specific deadline for RPAs will be announced when a disaster end date for the COVID-19 pandemic is established by FEMA.
