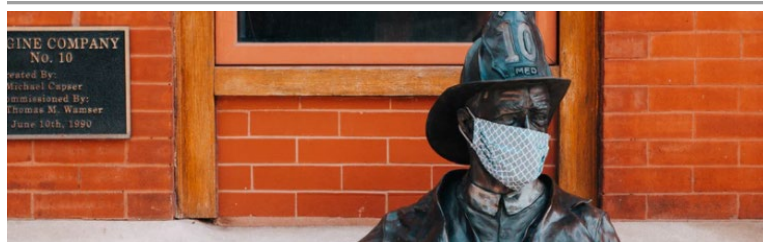

State EOC Updates

Tyvek Suits

The State EOC has received shipments of Tyvek suits from FEMA and will be distributing to counties who have requested them. The Logistics Section will be scheduling the deliveries beginning next week.

Nitrile Gloves

The State EOC is still waiting on nitrile gloves from FEMA. Gloves are expected to arrive within the next few weeks; however, an exact date has not been set yet. Once gloves are delivered, the Logistics Section will develop a distribution plan based on the quantity received from FEMA and county needs.

Stockpiling PPE

To date, the State EOC has completed PPE distributions to all counties based on requested needs through the end of 2020. If counties are wanting to stockpile and store extra PPE in addition to what the state has distributed, they are encouraged to purchase
