# Introduction

Effective July 1, 2020, the Indiana Health Coverage Programs began reimbursing EMS providers for administering naloxone.

# Details


EMS providers can bill for the drug and its administration.

- If the patient is not transported away from scene, EMS can bill for the drug and “Treat/No Transport”
- If EMS responds to the same patient multiple times on the same day, EMS can still bill if the encounters are separate and distinct
- IHCP will reimburse for naloxone given by a BLS non-transport provider
  - Must have a reimbursement agreement with EMS
  - Must have medical supervision protocol in place
  - Does not apply to law enforcement agencies
- Supplies of naloxone that were received via the Federal grant or free through another source CANNOT be reimbursed through Medicaid



# Drug Types

IHCP currently reimburses for two forms of naloxone; pre-filled nasal spray and vial.




# Billing Requirements

Drug Form	Administration of Naloxone	Naloxone Procedure Drug Code
Nasal Spray	96372 (U1 Modifier)	J3490
Liquid Vial	96372 (U2 Modifier)	J2310



# Documentation

In order to receive federal reimbursement for drugs, IHCP must have the National Drug Code along with each claim.



mL Multiple Dose Vial  
NDC 0641-2521-41  
NALOXONE

The NDC can be found on the packaging of the drug, as indicated above. EMS providers must record the full NDC, including dashes.



# Dosage

Providers are required to document both the procedure code amount and the NDC quantity in the patient care record.

Drug Form	Procedure Code Unit Size	NDC Quantity
Nasal Spray	One injector	One Unit (UN)
Liquid Vial	One milligram (mg)*	One milliliter (ML)



# Dosage

## Example of liquid vial dosage

Providers		Billing		
# of doses	mg amount	Procedure code units	NDC unit of measure	NDC quantity
1 dose	0.4 mg	1 unit	mL	1
2 doses	0.8 mg	1 unit	mL	2
3 doses	1.2 mg	2 units	mL	3
