RE: FY 2016 State Homeland Security Grant Program (SHSP) Competitive Project
Guidance

Purpose

The purpose of this Information Bulletin is to provide guidance and information regarding the Federal Fiscal Year (FFY) 2016 State Homeland Security Grant Program (SHSP) Guidance and the process for submitting proposals to be considered for inclusion in Indiana's FFY 2016 SHSP application.

Solicitation

Proposal submissions should focus on one or more of the following State identified priority areas as outlined in Section VI Funding Guidelines found in the 2016 Notice of Funding Opportunity (NOFO).

Federal Performance Period

The federal performance period of the 2016 SHSP grant begins on September 1, 2016 and ends on August 31, 2019.

Performance periods will be determined by the IDHS grants staff based on the approved proposal and budget.



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Instructions and Deadlines

Review the 2016 State Homeland Security Notice of Funding Opportunity (NOFO) prior to creating and submitting the proposal into iGMS. The requirements for submission will be included in the NOFO.

Letter of Intent Deadline: Friday, July 8, 2016

Letter of Intent must be completed and emailed to the IDHS Grants inbox at grants@dhs.in.gov.

Proposal/Budget Submission Deadline: Friday, July 22, 2016 at 11:59 PM

All budgets will be processed through the Indiana Grants Management System (iGMS): <http://myoracle.in.gov/hs>. Please use the proposal template named “**FY16 SHSP Competitive Grant Template**”.

- Budgets must be submitted via the iGMS no later than **Friday, July 22, 2016 at 11:59 PM**.
- All fields within each budget line item are required to be complete and must include the correct Authorized Equipment List (AEL) numbers for the purchase of equipment.
- Budgets submitted after the deadline of **Friday, July 22, 2016 at 11:59 PM** will not be considered for funding.

Before you can apply for an IDHS grant you must have or obtain a DUNS number and must be registered in the System for Awards Management (SAM), www.sam.gov. The applicant must provide a DUNS number with their application. This number is a required field for all subsequent steps in the application submission. Applicants should verify they have a DUNS number, or take the steps necessary to obtain one.

Applicants can receive a DUNS number at no cost by calling the DUNS number request line at (866) 705-5711. If you need assistance or have questions related to the DUNS number and SAM registration please contact IDHS Grants Management.

Other requirements for eligibility are outlined in the NOFO.

Proposal submission or approval does not guarantee funding

Awards and funding determinations are made based on the score of each grant and the priorities of the Indiana Department of Homeland Security. Submission and approval of a proposal does not guarantee funding.
