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FINAL ORDER OF DISMISSAL

On November 9, 2021, the parties filed an Executed Agreed Order and Stipulation of Dismissal for the above-captioned matter. The ultimate authority in this matter is the Fire Prevention and Building Safety Commission (Commission).

The Commission has authorized the Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) assigned by the Office of Administrative Law Proceedings to serve as the ultimate authority and thereby issue final orders of dismissal where the parties file a joint or agreed request to dismiss the appeal. The undersigned ALJ therefore issues this final order dismissing the above captioned matter with prejudice. Accordingly, the telephonic status conference set for December 13, 2021, is hereby vacated.

A person who wishes to seek judicial review of this final determination must file a petition for review in an appropriate court within thirty (30) days of this Order and must otherwise comply with the provisions of Ind. Code § 4-21.5-5.


AGREED ORDER AND STIPULATION OF DISMISSAL

The parties respectfully request these above captioned cases be dismissed. In support of this request, the parties state the following:


1. On October 4, 2021, Respondent performed an inspection of a facility located at 500 W. Logan Street, Markle, IN and issued a notice of violation to section 507.2.1 of the 2008 Indiana Mechanical Code. The notice of violation required the violation to be corrected by November 04, 2021.
2. On October 19, 2021, Petitioner filed their petition for review of this violation.
