



STATE HOMELAND SECURITY GRANT BULLETIN IB 16.G001 JULY 26, 2019

Purpose

The purpose of this Information Bulletin is to provide guidance regarding the requirements when applying for and expending 2016 State Homeland Security Grant (SHSP) deobligated funding.

Solicitation

To qualify for 2016 SHSP de-obligated funding, applicants must be able to complete all project activities, including purchasing, receiving goods and services, and finalizing all invoices, by **November 30, 2019**. Applicants must be able to initiate and complete project activities after receiving an award letter from IDHS. Applicants who have to wait for fully executed grant agreements to begin spending down funds are ineligible to apply for deobligated funding. Applicants should only submit applications for projects not requiring an Environmental Planning and Historic Preservation review.

Instructions and Deadlines

Grant Application Submission Deadline:

August 2, 2019 at 11:59 PM

All proposals/budgets will be processed through the Indiana Grants Management System (iGMS), which can be found via: <http://oas.dhs.in.gov/hs>. Please select the proposal template named “FY16 SHSP Deobligated Projects” Grant Template. Budgets must be submitted via iGMS by **August 2, 2019 at 11:59 PM**. All fields within each budget line item are required to be complete and must include the correct Authorized Equipment List (AEL) numbers for the purchase of equipment.

Applications submitted after the deadline will not be considered for funding.

One applicant may fill out and submit multiple applications within iGMS. It is possible the applicant may receive funding for multiple projects or none.

Applications will be evaluated on a “first come first serve” basis

Grant application submission is not a guarantee of funding

All applications will be reviewed in consideration with the funding priorities of agency.
