

Licensing Matters for Reciprocity - FPBSC 5/13/2026

I. Michigan Elevator Journeyperson Licensing (MCL - Section 338.2156)

Licensing Requirements:

- i. Three (3) years of continuous experience in the class(s) of elevator work in which he/she desires to be licensed.

*A degree in electrical or mechanical engineering may be substituted for one (1) year of experience. A copy of your engineering degree **MUST** be submitted with this application to be considered toward experience.

- ii. Examination (70% to pass) (Appears to be 100-150 questions)

IDHS recommends approving the Class A license, as it is comparable to Indiana's process for licensing elevator mechanics.

II. Georgia Class IIR License

Specific to wheelchair lifts, stairway chairlifts, and dumbwaiters.

IDHS recommends not approving this license, as it is not comparable to Indiana's elevator mechanic license.

III. Alabama Elevator Mechanic License (Administrative Code 480-8-3-.01)

Specific to platform lifts and stairway chair lifts.

IDHS recommends not approving this license, as it is not comparable to Indiana's elevator mechanic license.
