

CLASS B FOAM COLLECTION

The Indiana Department of Homeland Security (IDHS) and the Indiana Department of Environmental Management (IDEM) have launched a program to collect Per- and Polyfluoroalkyl (PFAS) foam from Indiana fire agencies.

The PFAS Initiative focuses on keeping firefighters safe. The state will remove and properly dispose of PFAS material from any agency that requests it. This is a free service with no additional requirements for fire agencies.

Class B Foam (also called AFFF) is used to extinguish Class B materials which include gasoline, oil and jet fuel.

Using Class B firefighting foam containing PFAS for training purposes is **prohibited** in Indiana as of 2020.
