Executive Order

PROCLAMATION

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY COME, GREETINGS:

- WHEREAS, emergency medical services (EMS) are a vital public service to the people and communities of Indiana; and
- WHEREAS, EMS professionals are frequently the entry point to Indiana's healthcare system; and
- WHEREAS, the State of Indiana strives to continually improve its EMS to provide all Hoosiers with the highest standards of emergency medical care, including the expansion of community-based public health services in 2020; and
- WHEREAS, EMS personnel, including emergency medical technicians, emergency medical responders, paramedics, dispatchers, emergency physicians, emergency nurses, firefighters, educators and administrators have engaged in many hours of specialized training to improve their lifesaving skills; and
- WHEREAS, Indiana is fortunate to have members of EMS teams available in Indiana communities 24 hours a day, seven days a week to provide emergency medical care; and
- WHEREAS, the State of Indiana is grateful for the gallantry and compassion shown by EMS professionals daily;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, **Eric J. Holcomb**, Governor of the State of Indiana, do hereby proclaim May 15~21, 2022 as

in the State of Indiana, and invite all citizens to duly note this occasion.
