FEDERAL DISASTER DECLARATION FACT SHEET

APRIL 3, 2020

Today, April 3, 2020, President Donald J. Trump granted a Major Disaster Declaration for the State of Indiana triggering the release of Federal funds to help communities recover from COVID-19 that occurred January 20, 2020, and continuing. Details of the disaster declaration and assistance programs are as follows:
