- F. Perform routine housekeeping duties.
- G. Assist in assigned details (pre-planning, prevention, inspections, public education, tours, etc.)
- H. Adhere to all rules, regulations, policies, and procedures.
- I. Demonstrate knowledge of fire department General Order and SOG's.
- J. Demonstrate knowledge of fire department safety standards.
- K. Properly complete any, and all, reports required by the Department.

POSITION REQUIREMENTS

- A. Skill in operation of:
 - 1. Vehicle under emergency conditions.
 - 2. EMS Equipment.
 - 3. Two-way radios (base, mobile, portable).
- B. Knowledge of:
 - 1. City of Lawrence Fire Department rules and regulations, policies and procedures.
 - 2. Taking appropriate action under stressful conditions.
 - 3. Handle routine public contacts in a professional manner.
 - 4. Perform basic mathematical functions.
 - 5. Deliver lectures, demonstrations, talks, etc.
 - 6. Prepare routine reports.
 - 7. Receive and follow directives.
- C. Other:
 - 1. Meet Department physical fitness standards.
 - 2. Tolerate heights encountered on a routine basis.
 - 3. Attend monthly in service training as provided by the fire department.

 - 1. State of Indiana Emergency Medical Technician Certification or Paramedic certification.

2. State of Indiana Valid Drivers Operators License.

3. High School Graduate or GED equivalent.

WORKING CONDITIONS

Work is performed at fire scenes and other emergency scenes and at fire

stations. Weather exposure includes extreme heat and cold: exposure to fire

scenes and extreme height at fire and emergency scenes.

Exposure to traffic

hazards occurs in emergency vehicles. Normal work hours are 24 hours on and

48 hours off; however, fluctuating schedules from time to time may require fewer

or more hours of work than the usual 24 hours per shift.

cardiovascular stress, and general stress are inherited by virtue of position and

various responsibilities carried out.
