**Education:**  
Must be at least 18 years of age and be a high school graduate or equivalent. EMT- Paramedic License and National Registry and State of Indiana License, as well as CPR, PALS (Pediatric Advanced Life Support), ACLS (Advanced Cardiac Life Support) required. Must obtain the State of Indiana EVOC certification, HazMat Operations level training, CPI (Crisis Prevention Intervention, and PHTLS or ITLS (Pre-Hospital Trauma Life Support) within one year of employment. Must also have proof of valid driver's license. Maintain eligibility for commercial driver's license, but does not have to obtain.

**Training:**  
Individualized preceptorship for 60 days for part-time and on-call positions. Time to be determined for full-time staff. May be more or less at the discretion of the Director. This is largely dependent on the number of patient contacts and the acuity of those contacts. Successful completion of orientation skills checklist.

**Experience:**  
Minimum of one year experience as an active EMT is preferred.

**Job Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities:**  
Must be a confident leader who can accept the challenge and high degree of responsibility entailed in this position. Must have excellent judgment, be able to prioritize decisions and act quickly in the best interest of the patient. Must be able to function independently in an optimum level in a non-structured environment that is constantly changing. The Paramedic must be able to remain calm while working in difficult and stressful situations, and stay focused

while assuming the leadership role inherent in carrying out the functions of the positions. Good judgment is essential in directing other team members to assist as needed, along with advanced knowledge, technical skills. The Paramedic must possess excellent verbal communication skills and be capable of adapting to situations with violence and emotional instability in multicultural settings . The Paramedic must possess critical thinking, reasoning and math skills and be capable of applying them effectively in stressful situations. Self motivation is essential.

**Job Description:**

The Paramedic responds to emergency and convalescent ambulance runs, works in the Emergency Department, and other nursing and ancillary departments as needed, in addition to working with various emergency response agencies in the area. Finds crews for call-ins or other needs. The Paramedic functions as the most extensively trained primary care provider in the pre-hospital setting and is responsible for all aspects of care provided to the sick and injured. The Paramedic provides both basic and advanced life support, including comprehensive patient assessment, invasive airway management, cardiac monitoring and administration of medications. The Paramedic is frequently in a leadership role working with a small team of lesser-trained pre-hospital care providers. The Paramedic works under the direct or indirect control of the medical director. Demonstrates knowledge of developmental needs of patient population specific to that department. (Patient population is defined in the department's Scope of Practice.)
