#### *Notice of Public Hearing*

Under IC 4-22-2-24, notice is hereby given that on October 18, 2010 at 9:00 a.m. EDT in the Training Room of the Ellettsville Fire Department, 5080 W. State Road 46, Bloomington, IN 47404 AND on October 19, 2010, at 9:00 a.m. EDT at the Indiana Government Center-South, 402 West Washington Street, Conference Center Room D, Indianapolis, Indiana 46204, AND on October 21, 2010 at 9:00 a.m. EDT in the Training Room of the Howard County/Kokomo Emergency Management Agency, 627 S. Berkley Road, Kokomo IN 46901 the Indiana Department of Homeland Security will hold public hearings, as required by IC 4-22-2-26, on proposed amendments to 290 IAC 1. The subject matter of the amendments and proposed new rule is to clarify and provide guidance concerning the post disaster process by which an eligible entity may make a claim for assistance under the State Disaster Relief Fund. The amendments are to 290 IAC 1-1-1 through 1-1-6. The amendments also add 290 IAC 1-1-0.5, 1-1-2.5, 1-1-7 and 290 IAC 1-2-1 through 1-2-8.

The proposed rules do not impose any requirement or cost on a regulated entity which is not expressly required by the authorizing statute.
