#### **Reports**

Director Kinney reports that the MIH Coordinator position within IDHS has been filled and then introduced Emily Castor in her new role. Touched on recent updates of the MIH mapping tool. The map will be slightly delayed but Ashley Moore will be training Director Kinney and Emily Castor to keep current on program additions.

### **Program Overview**

Lee Turpen discussed his program, ET3 (Emergency Treat, Triage and Transport), which will be operated out of Evansville through AMR. Lee gave an overview of the program as well as some of the recent outcomes as the result of their partnership with Telemedicine.

Lindsey Baywol from FSSA touched base again on the importance of completing the MIH Questionnaire as it is important to include all data about our MIH programs.

Dr. Yazel had a quest speaker for the meeting to discuss public Naloxone dispensing. Emily Pham with the Indiana Department of Health Trauma and Injury Prevention gave a brief overview of their Naloxone distribution programs. She reports that there is an application that goes out annually that Health Departments and Local First Responders can submit. They also offer trainings to ensure proper use of the medication as well to help prevent overdoses and one can find this information on their website.
