Indiana awaiting shipment from Strategic National Stockpile

Indiana received notification of an initial allocation of Personal Protection Equipment (PPE) from the Strategic National Stockpile (SNS) late last week by the Assistant Secretary for Preparedness and Response (ASPR). As of 8 a.m. Tuesday, this initial shipment has not been received and no update is available from the ASPR regarding shipping and delivery details.

Once Indiana receives the initial shipment, it will be used to start addressing immediate and critical PPE needs across the state. IDHS and ISDH continue to collect data through EMResource and conduct direct outreach with facilities when their PPE status turns to red to gather further information on their immediate need. Analysis continues for the constantly changing status of facility needs, which will ultimately drive the allocation strategy for the initial delivery. **At this time, the initial allocation will prioritize high risk, healthcare providers, and first responders.**

Additionally, a full SNS request was submitted to ASPR. To date, no further information is available.

If you have not updated EMResource please do so now. In order for the ISDH to be able to assist with resources as needed, EMS provider agencies (one account for each agency) are requested to have information reported into EMResource on a daily basis by 10:00 a.m. seven days a week.
