Zane Standridge – Investigative Summary and Board Recommendation

I. Summary of the Investigation and Findings of Facts:

On 12/10/2023, Officer Kyle Woods with the Auburn Police Department conducted a traffic stop involving Zane Standridge of the Huntertown Fire Department for failure to maintain lane. Officer Woods investigated for an OVWI and a certified breath test was conducted with a result of .089% g/210 L. On March 28, 2024, Standridge pled guilty to Operating a Vehicle with an Alcohol Concentration Equivalent to at least .08 but less than .15, a Class C Misdemeanor.

II. Authority to Sanction & Violations:

Authority to Sanction:

IC 22-12-7-7 allows the Board to revoke or suspend a license, censure, issue a letter of reprimand, or place a license holder on probation.

Violations:

1. Operating a Vehicle with an ACE of .08 or More, a Class C Misdemeanor, IC 9-30-5-1(a)

III. Recommendation:

The Board has the discretion to choose the sanction it finds appropriate, based upon the findings of the investigation. It is recommended to the Board by IDHS that Standridge receive a letter of reprimand.

Ultimately, the decision is in the hands of the Board, and a vote must be taken by the Board. After a vote takes place, IDHS will draft the Final Order for the Board Chairman's signature.
