## PROCLAMATION

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY COME, GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, flooding is Indiana's most frequent and costly disaster event and

since 1994 Indiana has received 12 disaster declarations related

to flooding; and

WHEREAS, August 24, 2016 brought devastating tornadoes to

Kokomo and other areas in Indiana, wherein late summer

tornadoes are not common; and

WHEREAS, from February 29 - March 3 of 2012, southern Indiana was

devastated by powerful storm activity that caused loss of life,

resulting in a federal disaster declaration; and

WHEREAS, the worst tornadoes often occur at night, such as the 2005 deadly

tornado in Evansville, which shows the importance of Hoosiers

having the ability to receive warnings 24 hours a day; and

WHEREAS, Hoosiers deserve to be informed of planning and preparedness

best practices that help minimize the number of weather-related deaths and injuries and are invaluable in helping individuals, families and businesses recover quickly and completely from

emergencies and disasters;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Eric J. Holcomb, Governor of the State of Indiana, do hereby proclaim March 12-18, 2023 as
