SERTC provides world-recognized surface transportation incident training courses. Participants will experience full-scale, immersive training to prepare them for real-world hazmat and surface transportation emergencies.

To attend these trainings, approval and application FIRST must be made to SERTC at www.sertc.org.

1. Send completed SERTC application for the specific course to Justin Stump, jstump@dhs.in.gov (317-617-4235). Application must be signed by department supervisor before being submitted.
2. Once received, signups for the course will take place in the Acadis Portal. Both actions must be taken to be approved for the training.

Applicants must be certified hazmat technicians and have completed NIMS 100, 200 and 700. Applicants also cannot have attended a SERTC course in the last three (3) years.
