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How do I get to the application screen in Gateway?

Each user has a specific username and password that will allow access to Gateway. The username is the email address on file with the Department of Local Government Finance (DLGF). Users without a Gateway account may contact gateway@dlgf.in.gov to register.

For those counties that offer property tax relief credits, users will need to enter their Final PTRC Balance as of December 31 of the previous calendar year and the current allocation percentages for the various property tax relief credits: All Property, 1%, 2%, 3%, Residential, and Former Qualified Residential. In the event the user does not know the current allocation percentages for their county’s property tax relief credits, they should click the “I don’t know” option.

Additionally, users will be asked to verify and enter information pertaining to Phase-In and MTE (Municipal Tax Exemption) state assigned taxing districts. The Pre-Abstract Survey will be pre-populated with a list of state assigned taxing districts that were listed as either a Phase-In or MTE based on data reported in the previous year's abstract. Users should verify that the pre-populated list is still accurate and make any necessary edits, such updating the Phase-In year for the applicable state assigned taxing district. Furthermore, if a Phase-In or MTE state assigned taxing district is new for the current pay year, users will need to add that district's information under the "Add a new MTE or Phase-In taxing district" section by selecting the appropriate taxing district from the drop down menu and clicking "Add" button.

Special Taxing Districts

Counties have the option of adopting phase in rates for taxing districts during an annexation process. Phase in rates are used to gradually change the tax rate seen by parcels that move taxing district to ease the tax burden. MTE stands for Municipal Tax Exemption. These are taxing districts that are created by county council action that have to be manually added to first version of the abstract that AOS receives from DLGF.

After an option has been selected for each question, a "Submit Survey" button will appear at the bottom of the screen. User should press this button in order to transmit their survey information to the State.

File Upload

Please note that the Pre-Abstract Survey must be completed and submitted in Gateway prior to the county uploading any of their abstract files.

Once the county is selected, users will be directed to the Unit Main Menu page. To access the File Upload, the user should select "File Upload" on the left side of the page.

There are a total of seven files that can be uploaded. They consist of the TAXDATA, ADJMENTS, ABTAXSUPP, ABCERTRATE, TIFSUMM, TIFTAX, and TIFTAXSUPP files. The 7 files may be uploaded individually, or together as 1 zip file. All 7 files must be successfully uploaded before the system will begin performing calculations. If you receive an error with your file upload, please contact your local software vendor.

Please note that if you have previously uploaded a set of Gateway Abstract files and have performed calculations on those files, doing another iteration of uploading the Gateway Abstract files and running the calculations will overwrite the results from the previous round of calculations.

Once users select the blue "Upload" button, the Gateway Abstract files that were provided by the county's tax and billing system may be uploaded.

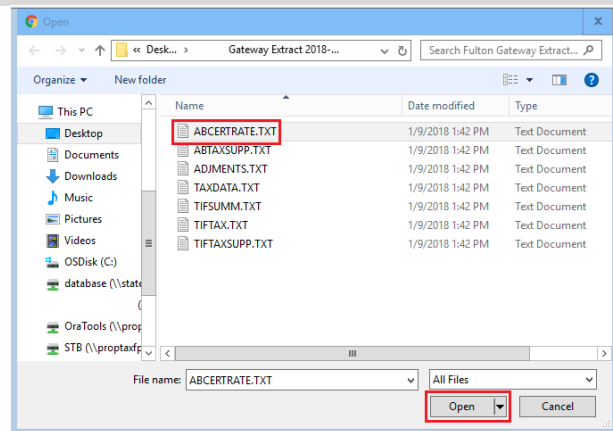
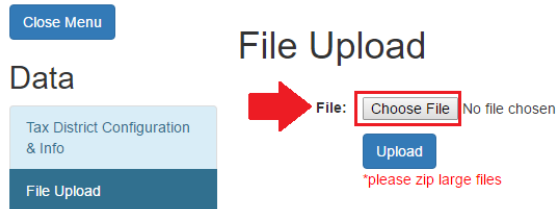

Please note that the Gateway Abstract files must follow specifications provided to the tax and billing software vendors by the DLGF. Using a file that does not follow the prescribed specifications will likely result in an upload error.

2. Click “Choose File” and Open the selected file.

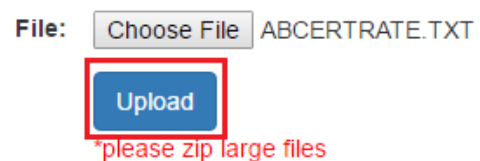
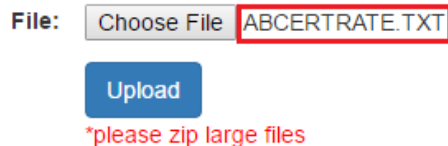


3. Verify the correct file is opened.

Immediately after uploading the file, a yellow box will appear in both the “Current Upload” and “All Upload” status boxes for the uploaded file(s), notifying the user that the file has been uploaded and is currently processing.

If, after 5 minutes, the File Status has not changed, please click on “File Upload” under the “Data” section on the left of the application.

In the event “Errors(s) in row data” appears under the “File Status” column, users may click on the “Details” button to the right in order to see the list of records that are resulting in a file processing error and to see what the nature of the error is. This information will be helpful to share with the county’s tax and billing software vendor when the user contacts the vendor to help troubleshoot the upload errors with the file.

Please note that the “Run Calculations for Upload” option should not be selected until all seven files have been successfully processed (i.e., the File Status states “Completed” and the box appears green for each of the seven files).

Before the Auditor is able to submit the Gateway Abstract, all five (5) sections 1) Net Assessed values, 2) Tax Rates and Levies, 3) Total Taxes, 4) TIF, & 5) Taxing District Summaries) of the Abstract application must first be reviewed.




If a section still has an area or areas that have not yet been reviewed, that section will display in red on the “Confirmation of Reviews and Signature” page.

Submission

Once all the data has been reviewed and any required explanations have been provided for the various review checks, the county auditor will need to personally enter their name, title, and specific Gateway PIN number to submit the information as the last step in the abstract submission process. If the auditor cannot remember their 4 digit PIN number, please have the auditor personally email gateway@dlgf.in.gov and request that their PIN number be sent to them.
