SUBJECT: 2021 Local Income Tax Estimates

DATE: September 18, 2020

Governor Eric Holcomb issued Executive Order #20-31 on June 3, 2020. The Order extends certain statutory deadlines for the calculation and distribution of local income tax (“LIT”) revenue. The Department of Local Government Finance (“Department”) issued a memo that outlines the several key provisions of the Order on June 8, 2020, available at this link:

Included in those changes was an extension of the deadline under IC 6-3.6-9-5(a) for the State Budget Agency to provide to the Department and each county auditor an estimate of the distribution of LIT revenue to the county from August 2, 2020, to September 15, 2020. On September 16, the Department posted the 2021 LIT estimates on the Department’s website:
