Indiana Code Citation IC 6-3.6-9-15 requires the State Budget Agency to provide the amount of supplemental distributions for qualifying counties to the Department of Local Government Finance before May 2nd. The supplemental distribution is disbursed to counties that have a balance in the county trust account exceeding fifteen percent (15%) of the certified distribution to be made to the county in the year of determination.

In accordance with IC 6-3.6-9-15 supplemental distributions are made to the following counties listed in the table below. These amounts are based on the most current information available on the adjusted ending balances for CY 2017. In calculating the supplemental distributions, the ending balances for CY 2017 were adjusted for the supplemental and special distributions made in CY 2018 in accordance with the requirements of the code.
