A special meeting of the Board of School Trustees of the Lake Station Community School Corporation was held at Edison Jr. Sr. High School at 3304 Parkside Avenue, Lake Station, Indiana, on May 9, 2023, at the hour of 5:20 p.m., pursuant to notice duly given in accordance with Indiana Code § 20-26-4-3 and Indiana Code § 5-14-1.5, and the rules of the Board.

The meeting was called to order by the President of the Board.


On call of the roll, the members of the Board were shown to be present or absent as follows:



The Board considered a resolution authorizing the renewal of an operating referendum (Motion made by Trustee David Wright to adopt the resolution attached as Exhibit A. Seconded by Trustee Kevin Music and adopted the Operating Referendum Authorizing Resolution attached hereto as Exhibit A by a vote of 3 (Greggory Tenorio, David Wright and Kevin Music) in favor and 2 (Larry Biggs and Karen Curtis) abstaining.

Motion made by Trustee Greg Tenorio to adjourn the meeting. Seconded by Trustee David Wright. Meeting adjourned.

**A RESOLUTION OF THE LAKE STATION COMMUNITY SCHOOLS
TO EXTEND OPERATING REFERENDUM LEVY**

WHEREAS, Indiana Code 20-46-1-8.5, as amended, authorizes a public-school corporation to adopt a resolution to extend a referendum levy under Indiana Code 20-46-1-1, as amended, on the ballot before December 31 of the final calendar year in which the school corporation's previously approved referendum levy was imposed if the governing body of the school corporation determines that the school corporation cannot, in a calendar year, carry out its public educational duty unless it imposes a referendum tax levy under Indiana Code 20-46-1-1, as amended;

WHEREAS, the Board of School Trustees of the Lake Station Community Schools (the "Board"), being the governing body of the Lake Station Community Schools in Lake County, Indiana ("the School Corporation") has determined that based on current revenue calculations, the School Corporation will not be able to carry out its public educational duty unless it extends the current referendum tax levy; and,

WHEREAS, a copy of the proposed Revenue Spending Plan was prepared pursuant to the Act and presented to the Board in the form attached hereto as Exhibit A (the "Revenue Spending Plan");

WHEREAS, based on the foregoing, the Board now desires to adopt a resolution to place an extension of its current referendum levy on the ballot pursuant to the Act;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of School Trustees of Lake Station Community Schools that this Board hereby determines that the School Corporation will not be able to carry out its public educational duty beyond the current referendum levy unless it renews the current referendum tax levy at the same rate, which shall not exceed \$0.54 per \$100 assessed valuation, and that the School Corporation does not plan to distribute any revenue from the referendum levy to a charter school all in accordance with the Act.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the School Corporation shall request that the operating referendum levy extension be placed on the ballot at an election to be held on November 7, 2023.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the question to be submitted to the voters in the referendum renewal shall read as follows: **"Shall Lake Station Community Schools continue to impose increased property taxes paid to the School Corporation by homeowners and businesses for eight (8) years immediately following the holding of the referendum for the purpose of funding school bus transportation, maintaining and expanding academic programs, recruitment and retention of teachers and staff, student safety and security services, and other educational needs?"** The property tax increase requested in this referendum was originally approved by the voters in 2017 and originally increased the average property tax paid to the School Corporation per year on a residence within the School Corporation by 47.13% and originally increased the average property tax paid to the School Corporation per year on a business property within the School Corporation by 55.83%.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Secretary of the Board, the Superintendent or the Director of Finance shall certify a copy of this resolution to the DLGF for approval of the form of the question as set forth above pursuant to the Act.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Revenue Spending Plan is hereby adopted and the Board agrees that such plan may be amended and supplemented each year as part of the School Corporation's budget process as permitted by Indiana Law.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that following DLGF approval of the form of the question set forth above the Secretary of the Board shall certify a copy of this resolution and the DLGF's approval to the Lake County Council and the Clerk of the Lake Circuit Court pursuant to the Act.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Board, the Superintendent or the Director of Finance are authorized to submit to the DLGF or Lake County any revisions to the proposed form of question in order to comply with the Act.
