



DNR 30-DAY PUBLIC NOTICE

The Department of Natural Resources serves the DNR 30-Day Public Notice in order to satisfy the requirements of the "Procedures Concerning Certain Licenses Act", IC 14-11-4, and its associated administrative rule, 312 IAC 2-3.

The DNR 30-Day Public Notice is published weekly to serve notice of the latest permit applications received at the DNR, Division of Water. This Notice can be viewed on the web at http://www.in.gov/dnr/water/ and can be provided by email upon written request. Petition for Public Hearing

A pre-action public hearing on an application may be requested by filing a written petition. For a petition to be considered valid it must:

- 1. contain the typed or legibly printed name and complete mailing address of each petitioner;
- 2. be signed by a minimum of 25 individuals who are at least 18 years old and either reside in the county where the project will take place or own real property within 1 mile of the project site;
- 3. affirm that each signatory to the petition satisfies the requirements of item 2; and
- 4. identify the application for which the public hearing is being requested either by the application # or the applicant's name and the project description.

A petition which does not meet these requirements will be considered invalid and the hearing request will not be granted. To request a pre-action public hearing, send the petition by email to water_inquiry@dnr.in.gov or by mail to:

Project Description: An approximate 25' x 30' area along the stream bank was stabilized with class 1 riprap to protect the bank from further erosion. The riprap was keyed into the streambed at its base and conforms to the existing bank at the project limits. It has a maximum height of 30', a maximum streamward projection of 2' beyond the existing bank, and 1:1 sideslopes.

Project Description: The existing bridge carrying US 421 over Eagle Creek will be rehabilitated. The project will include resurfacing of the bridge deck, replacing and updating guardrails, and adding riprap around piers for scour protection. The current structure is 165' long and 46.5' wide on a 30-degree skew. Class 1A riprap will be installed around Pier 2 and Pier 3. The riprap for each pier will measure approximately 66' long, 12' wide, and 3' deep. The riprap installed on the side slopes will measure 68' long, 20.5' wide, and 2' and will create a wildlife crossing. In total, riprap placed below the base flood elevation will cover approximately 0.112 acres and will consist of 422 cubic yards of material. Temporary impacts will result from construction of access roads and installation of cofferdams and erosion control measures. The cofferdams and erosion control will cover approximately 0.446 acres and will consist of 822 cubic yards of material. Tree trimming and some tree removal will take place, impacting less than 0.09 acres. No mitigation is anticipated. Des. # 2002084.

Project Description: As part of the 141st Street Trail project, two (2) twin 54.5' long by 6' wide CMP pipes will be extended by 10' each and lined with a cured-in-place pipe liner. Structure 100 is 54.4' long by 6' wide and Structure 101 is 54.3' long by 6' wide. A new headwall, wingwalls and riprap will also be placed at the inlet for scour protection. The crossings connect the concrete multi-use path along the north and south side of West 141st Street. Temporary cofferdams and filter socks will be needed to complete the project and is estimated to be in place for approximately six (6) months. Once the project is completed, the cofferdams and filter socks will be removed and disturbed areas will be seeded. Mitigation will be done for the tree clearing that will occur.
