DNR 30-DAY PUBLIC NOTICE

The Department of Natural Resources serves the DNR 30-Day Public Notice in order to satisfy the requirements of the "Procedures Concerning Certain Licenses Act", IC 14-11-4, and its associated administrative rule, 312 IAC 2-3.

The DNR 30-Day Public Notice is published weekly to serve notice of the latest permit applications received at the DNR, Division of Water. This Notice can be viewed on the web at <http://www.in.gov/dnr/water/> and can be provided by email upon written request. Petition for Public Hearing

A pre-action public hearing on an application may be requested by filing a written petition. For a petition to be considered valid it must:

1. contain the typed or legibly printed name and complete mailing address of each petitioner;
2. be signed by a minimum of 25 individuals who are at least 18 years old and either reside in the county where the project will take place or own real property within 1 mile of the project site;
3. affirm that each signatory to the petition satisfies the requirements of item 2; and
4. identify the application for which the public hearing is being requested either by the application # or the applicant's name and the project description.

A petition which does not meet these requirements will be considered invalid and the hearing request will not be granted. To request a pre-action public hearing, send the petition by email to water_inquiry@dnr.in.gov or by mail to:

Project Description: An approximate 600' by 350' area of the intake at Markland Hydro Generation Station will be dredged to a depth of 374' MSL per original design. The dredging will be performed only as needed by a suction dredge, long reach, or clamshell. The excavated material will be disposed of in a location previously approved by the Army Corps of Engineers which is an upland detention area near the site and beyond the limits of the floodway, or disposed of within a municipal landfill. This is a reauthorization of FW-31449.

Project Location: Beginning approximately 300' upstream from the State Route 1 stream crossing, extending approximately 600' further upstream near Florence

Project Description: A new 130' long steel sheet piling seawall will be installed and will be backfilled with clean sand. All existing concrete debris and rocks will be moved landward in a straight line along the shoreline of the St. Joseph River. The steel sheet piling layer will have 2.3' of exposure above the stream bed and will be capped with an angle iron top cap. Deadman anchors will be comprised of 4' sections of steel every 8' along the new steel sheet piling and connected to the steel seawall with 5/8" rod. The fill area will be 130' long, 2' high, and 2' wide.

Project Description: An existing, concrete seawall will be removed and replaced with a new concrete seawall along 100' on both the north and south bank of the river to deter bank erosion. The new wall will be approximately 2.5' high, as measured from the riverbed, will have the same alignment as the existing wall, and will tie into existing seawalls located on adjacent properties located to the east and west. The piling will be driven approximately 7' into the riverbed and will be anchored with deadmen spaced at 10' intervals. A whaler will be placed across the face of the wall to further stabilize the pilings. Clean fill will be brought onsite to backfill the area landward of the new seawall. The fill will be leveled with the top of the wall at the river and will be tapered back to existing ground elevations within the project site.

Project Description: Utilities (water and electric service) will be upgraded to 74 campsites. A new water line will be installed from SR 135 to the existing comfort station along with additional frost free hydrants. New electric transformers and 50 amp service will be installed to the 74 sites. Also, the gravel campsites will be reconfigured to enlarge sites. All proposed fill will primarily be 4" gravel base and 4" topdress for these sites along with 4" topdressing of existing roads. The number of hitching rails will be reduced and adding steel upgrades with the same approximate dimensions as the existing rails. There will be an addition of approximately 200 new trees in the area.

Project Description: The existing abandoned bridge carrying the B&O Railroad over Barnette Ditch will be replaced with a new structure on essentially the same alignment. The pedestrian bridge will be a 1-span steel beam bridge with span lengths of 14.25'. The structure will have an out-to-out length of 15.167' and a clear roadway width of 12'. The spill through abutments will have 2:1 sideslopes armored with riprap, which will be approximately 18" in depth and 3' wide. The abutments and piers will be skewed 0 degrees to align with the streamflow. The new approach roads will be elevated a maximum of 1.75' above the existing approaches. The existing structure will be completely removed. The project is federally funded.
