The DNR 30-Day Public Notice is published weekly to serve notice of the latest permit applications received at the DNR, Division of Water. Petition for Public Hearing

A pre-action public hearing on an application may be requested by filing a written petition. For a petition to be considered valid it must:

1. contain the typed or legibly printed name and complete mailing address of each petitioner;
2. be signed by a minimum of 25 individuals who are at least 18 years old and either reside in the county where the project will take place or own real property within 1 mile of the project site;
3. affirm that each signatory to the petition satisfies the requirements of item 2; and
4. identify the application for which the public hearing is being requested either by the application # or the applicant's name and the project description.

A petition which does not meet these requirements will be considered invalid and the hearing request will not be granted. To request a pre-action public hearing, send the petition by email to water_inquiry@dnr.in.gov or by mail to:

Project Description: The existing 304' long, 54" diameter corrugated metal pipe (CMP) culvert (CV 067-055-83.30) will be lined with a 1.5" CIPP liner, and partially grouted class 2 riprap will be placed at the outlet and along the bank opposite the outlet to dissipate energy and armor the channel (INDOT Des. No. 2200596). Permanent impacts will include the placement of riprap. Temporary impacts will include a temporary sandbag cofferdam with a pump around on Unnamed Tributary #1 and #2 to the White River that will be in place for approximately 6 weeks. The cofferdams will measure approximately 4' in length, 2' in width and 1' in height. The wildlife passage through the structure will be improved as a result of the placement of partially grouted riprap, which will be installed at grade and placed in a way that creates a ramp. Approximately 0.06 acres of tree removal will be required.

Project Description: As part of the East 136th Street reconstruction project, single span steel truss pedestrian bridges will be constructed on the north and south side of the East 136th Street vehicular bridge to carry pedestrian traffic over Mud Creek. Through the floodplain, the horizontal alignment of the pedestrian paths will somewhat parallel the existing East 136th Street horizontal alignment. Over Mud Creek, the pedestrian paths will be offset 39.5' from the centerline of the existing East 136th Street bridge. The pedestrian path vertical alignment approaching each pedestrian bridge will be above the existing road by a maximum of 3.4'. Each pedestrian bridge would provide a 14' clear path and will be 71.33' long. The vehicular bridge adjacent to the pedestrian bridges will not be modified. The project is federally funded.

This is a resubmission of FW-32057. The low structure elevation of the proposed pedestrian bridges have been lowered to eliminate surcharge from the hydraulic modeling.

All sediments will be pumped from lake. No re-deposit or incidental fallback will result. Approximately 125,000 cys of material will be dredged. No fill is to be placed within the regulatory floodway associated with the dredging activity.

Project Description: A logjam has accumulated against the bridge abutments at River Road/South County Road 900 West. Heavy equipment will be used to remove the logjam, utilizing an existing logjam and sandbar to access most of the material. Access from the north side of the river is not possible, so equipment must track across the river approximately 10 yards upstream of the bridge to retrieve logjam material from the other side. Equipment will track in the same location each time they cross, minimizing the disturbed riverbed. In the interest of the safety of waterway users, the existing canoe launch/boat ramp must be re-oriented to face downstream, avoiding a side channel and scour hole. This will require the removal of two trees, one mature silver maple approximately 12" dbh, and a dead silver maple that is slightly smaller. The trees will be removed during the winter months so as to avoid bat habitat restrictions.
