Petition for Public Hearing

A pre-action public hearing on an application may be requested by filing a written petition. For a petition to be considered valid it must:

1. contain the typed or legibly printed name and complete mailing address of each petitioner;
2. be signed by a minimum of 25 individuals who are at least 18 years old and either reside in the county where the project will take place or own real property within 1 mile of the project site;
3. affirm that each signatory to the petition satisfies the requirements of item 2; and
4. identify the application for which the public hearing is being requested either by the application # or the applicant's name and the project description.

A petition which does not meet these requirements will be considered invalid and the hearing request will not be granted. To request a pre-action public hearing, send the petition by email to water_inquiry@dnr.in.gov or by mail to:

Project Description: A new 3' high by 4' wide glacial stone seawall will be constructed along 345' along the shoreline and will have a finished slope of 4H:3V. The new seawall will be comprised of approximately 6" and up to 34" in diameter glacial stone on top of washed river rock and geotextile fabric. Geotextile fabric will be used to separate the soil from the native drainage stone behind the seawall.

Approximately 526,122 square feet of fill will be placed within floodway limits for the asphalt parking lot and access road.

Project Description: Reaches 7-8 of the Elliott Ditch Soil and Isolated Sediment remediation project will be done to remove PCB-impacted soil and isolated sediment for transportation and offsite, landfill disposal. To facilitate access to the remedial areas, targeted tree clearing will be required. Sediment remediation includes one depositional feature in Reach 7 (Milepost 3.53). Soil removal in Reaches 7 and 8 will be performed across geomorphic surfaces that have been analyzed and determined to be impacted with PCB concentrations exceeding a Risk-Based Remedial Objective (RBRO). On average, removal is anticipated to be up to 2' to 3' below grade. Following sediment and soil removal activities, clean backfill will be installed. Backfill soil will be installed to match pre-excavation elevations. All disturbed upland areas will be stabilized with native grass species.

The spill through abutments will have a maximum of 2:1 sideslopes armored with Class 1 riprap. The abutments and piers will be skewed 25 degrees to align with the streamflow. The new approach roads will be elevated a maximum of 1' above the existing approaches. The existing structure will be completely removed. The project is federally funded and had Des No 2101764.

Project Description: A new public park, pedestrian bridge, and stream bank stabilization are proposed along the banks of Eel River in the Town of North Manchester. The project extends approximately 800' along Eel River's centerline from Market Street bridge east, around the riverbend, and south to Hill Street and Ogan's Landing. The pedestrian bridge is approximately 650' upstream from the Market Street bridge and bridge is a single-span prefabricated parabolic steel truss pedestrian bridge set above the base flood elevation (BFE) of the river with a low structure elevation of 755.0'. The elevation of the bridge will require grade differential between the bridge and park, accommodated by an ADA-accessible boardwalk ramp supported by concrete piles. Approximately 200' of riverbank restoration will be done just upstream of Market Street bridge on the right overbank.

The fill material will be hauled in from a stone quarry and an asphalt plant. Any disturbed areas adjoining the driveway will be seeded to match the existing ground cover.

The existing piers are identical extending 150' lakeward of the shoreline and featuring 3' wide pier fingers that extend 24' laterally from the main pier on both sides. The southern most pier features 5' fingers spaced 24' apart on each side of the pier. The middle pier has 5 fingers on the southern side and 4 fingers on the northern side. The northern most pier features 6 fingers on each side of the main pier. The northern most pier connects to a shoreline dock that features an additional 5 fingers. Within the reconfiguration the piers will be shifted approximately 10' to the north. The three main piers will be spaced approximately 72' apart. Additional boat slips will be added at the end of each pier with addition of a 64' lateral pier off the end of each main pier. Each lateral pier will have six 20' fingers extending lakeward. A 48' long by 6' wide ADA accessible gang way will be installed with a hand railing at landward most portion of the the northern pier. The dock and pier width in this area will be approximately 10' wide. The northern most pier fingers will terminate approximately 5' north of the property line within a 10' easement area between properties. The southern most pier fingers will terminate 40' from the southern property line.
