The Department of Natural Resources serves the DNR 30-Day Public Notice in order to satisfy the requirements of the "Procedures Concerning Certain Licenses Act", IC 14-11-4, and its associated administrative rule, 312 IAC 2-3.

The DNR 30-Day Public Notice is published weekly to serve notice of the latest permit applications received at the DNR, Division of Water. Petition for Public Hearing

A pre-action public hearing on an application may be requested by filing a written petition. For a petition to be considered valid it must:

1. contain the typed or legibly printed name and complete mailing address of each petitioner;
2. be signed by a minimum of 25 individuals who are at least 18 years old and either reside in the county where the project will take place or own real property within 1 mile of the project site;
3. affirm that each signatory to the petition satisfies the requirements of item 2; and
4. identify the application for which the public hearing is being requested either by the application # or the applicant's name and the project description.

A petition which does not meet these requirements will be considered invalid and the hearing request will not be granted. To request a pre-action public hearing, send the petition by email to water_inquiry@dnr.in.gov or by mail to:

Project Description: An 8' wide concrete ramp, stabilized with pre-cast concrete retaining wall blocks will be constructed along the Ohio River bank. The ramp will be supported with compacted #57 stone and will have a 4" diameter to drain stormwater. There will also be class 1 riprap at the base of the wall closest to the riverbank. In addition, a residential home has been removed and a new one will be constructed outside of the floodway.

The ponds will be excavated to no deeper than 18" with the spoil material used to enhance the overall depth. Side slopes will be 15:1 or flatter. The ponds will be a zero net fill project and all material will remain on site. There are no trees at the site.

Project Description: The existing 8" diameter pipeline will be removed and replaced via horizontal directional drilling. The 16" diameter pipeline will remain covered. The creek banks will be stabilized by being graded to create more gentle slopes, less prone to erosion, and approximately 430 cubic yards of 12" diameter riprap that will be placed along the graded banks to stabilize the stream and protect the 16" pipeline. Keyways will also be installed that will measure approximately 20' long x 5' wide x 3' deep. The riprap will be placed along approximately 217 linear feet of the stream. Temporary impacts will include a staging area and a 20' wide x 591 linear foot access road. Ten trees within the work area will be removed to facilitate project construction. Approximately 0.06 acres of pre-emergent wetland will be temporarily impacted along the access route. Upon project completion, the area will be seeded with a native seed mix, and mulched. Leno-woven erosion control blanket will be placed on all disturbed slopes.

Project Description: The Jefferson County Highway Department plans to proceed with a bridge rehabilitation project involving Structure No. 39-00171 located along Clifty Hollow Road over Big Clifty Creek (Des No. 2201626). The project work will include the rehabilitation of Jefferson County Bridge No. 171 with a rigid deck overlay and a semi-integral end bent conversion. The deck will be milled and overlaid with a 2" rigid concrete overlay. Partial patching and full depth patching will be completed as necessary. The existing 44' clear roadway width will be reduced to 43.5' to accommodate the installation of new bridge railing. The 46.5' out-to-out will be maintained. The steel superstructure will be cleaned and repainted. The existing bearings at the end bents will be replaced with elastomeric bearing pads, and the existing bearings at the piers will be cleaned and painted. Approach slabs and approach guardrail will be replaced. The approach reconstruction/mill and overlay will extend approximately 90' west and 115' east of the bridge approaches to match the existing pavement. Permanent impacts are expected to be approximately 0.035 acres for the placement of class 1 riprap. Temporary impacts are expected to be approximately 0.062 acres for the use of temporary cofferdams for dewatering. These temporary measures will be in place for 8 weeks. No tree clearing will be required.

Project Description: A 20' by 65' area will be excavated and filled in the mapped floodway of Henley Ditch for a small electrical substation pad expansion. The fill placed will generally follow the excavation on the east side of Henley Ditch. The work will be set approximately 50' back from the top of the bank. The finished elevation of the fill will be above the base flood elevation. The fill material will be stone imported from a quarry.

The new structures will be twin single span concrete bulb-tee beam bridges with an out-to-out coping width of 41.7' and a span of 123.5'. Mechanically Stabilized Earth (MSE) walls will be installed, and revetment riprap will be placed along the banks for scour protection. The path along the northeast bank will remain in its existing condition to facilitate the safe passage of wildlife beneath the structures. Tree clearing will be required as a part of this project and will be mitigated for. (INDOT Des. Nos. 2300752 and 2300753)

Project Description: The proposed project consists of wind energy facility construction in Blackford County, Indiana. All wind turbine foundations and permanent turbine components will be located outside of the regulated floodway. Temporary access routes will extend into the regulated floodway solely to accommodate large construction equipment during turbine installation. Floodway activities will be temporary and limited to equipment maneuvering, turnaround, and work conducted from 12" thick timber construction mats placed on existing agricultural ground surfaces. The construction easement and maximum area of temporary disturbance within the regulated floodway is approximately 1.52 acres and is located a minimum of 400' offset from the top of bank of Walnut Creek to the south. Upon completion, all temporary components and materials will be removed and impacted areas will be restored to pre-existing grades, soils will be recompacted as necessary, and disturbed areas will be stabilized.

Project Description: The existing Tippecanoe County Bridge No. 64 (Structure No. 79-00064/NBI No. 7900043) and Tippecanoe County Bridge No. 65 (Structure No. 79-00065/NBI No. 7900044) will be replaced. Bridge 64 carries Lilly Road over an unnamed tributary (UNT) to Wea Creek and Bridge 65 carries Lilly Road over Wea Creek. Riprap (1128.6 cubic yards) will be placed for scour protection. Riprap, 1128.6 cubic yards of 24" class 1 riprap and 48" class 2 riprap will be placed for scour protection. The waterway opening of Bridge 65 will increase from 549.74 square feet to 1216.55 square feet. Permanent habitat impacts include 0.87 acre of non-wetland tree removal, 0.12 acre of early successional habitat disturbance, and 0.01 acre of wetland tree removal. Temporary cofferdams and dewatering equipment will be needed to complete the project. Along the bridge abutment spill slopes of both bridges, wildlife passage consisting of a compacted aggregate shelf above the ordinary high water mark (OHWM) of the streams will be installed.

Project Description: INDOT Crawfordsville District proposes to proceed with an intersection improvement project at the intersection of SR 39 and Keller Hill Road. The proposed project will construct a roundabout at the existing intersection, outside of the McCracken Creek floodway. The placement of detention berms and ditch regrading for detention basins will occur along the southern portion of the SR 39 roadway within the floodway of McCracken Creek. Permanent impacts from the placement and removal of fill within the McCracken Creek floodway will occur for the placement of detention berms, and ditch regrading for detention basins. Total permanent impacts within the floodway equals 0.223 acres, 202.8 cubic yards of fill placement, and 203.6 cubic yards of fill removal. Net fill removal equals 0.8 cubic yards. All areas disturbed below the BFE will be reseeded with an approved Floodway Mix.

Project Description: In total the project includes excavation and backfill, culvert replacement in kind and a new culvert, ditch stabilization, rip rap placement, and asphalt pavement replacement. The existing 24" CMP culvert with two 24" C-900 pipes. Excavation will occur to remove the existing culvert and the additional 40 linear feet for the second new C-900 pipe. The existing stone headwall on either side of the existing CMP culvert will be removed and replaced. The project will also include placement of rip rap around the new culverts and along the ditch for bank stabilization.

The refacing will consist of concrete which will be tied to the existing wall with #4 rebar. The refacing will have a maximum thickness of 5" and will be sloped on the lakeward side. A 12" inch wide layer of riprap will be placed at the base of the wall for toe protection. A 5", 14'x 20' radius patio will be constructed on top and landward of the lakeward face of the refaced wall.
